### SUMMARY

#### Synopsis of Bill

House Bill 217 appropriates \$200 thousand from the general fund to the Second Judicial District Court for the purpose of establishing a specialty court to serve the elderly and disabled population.

### FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The appropriation of \$200 thousand contained in this bill is a recurring expense to the general fund. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2015 shall revert to the general fund.
