The memorial states Mr. and Mrs. Robinson played instrumental roles in New Mexico as well as federally with Mr. Robinson's work with the United States State Department. The Robinson's dedicated their time and effort to different institutions: St. John's College; the Santa Fe Opera; the New Mexico School of Arts; plus many more.

Mr. Robinson received New Mexico's first visionary designer lifetime achievement award in 2007 and the United States department of state distinguished honor award in 1977. Mr. and Mrs. Robinson received the Santa Fe mayor's award in 2009 for their support of the arts in Santa Fe.
