House Memorial 75 requests the Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC) to conduct a survey of New Mexico DWI sentencing and probation management practices as well as study the practices of other states to evaluate the efficacy of introducing and expanding practices to reduce DWI recidivism.

The memorial requests the AOC to report findings to the appropriate legislative committee during the 2014 interim.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The AOC will have to pay costs associated with the creation of the task force, but it is likely that this cost will be absorbed into the base budget.
