House Memorial 88 celebrates the life and career of Ralph Kiner, a hall of fame baseball player and a New Mexico original.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

House Memorial 88 states Ralph Kiner was born in Santa Rita, New Mexico and served honorably as a United States navy pilot during World War II. Kiner played outfield for the Pittsburgh Pirates, Chicago Cubs and Cleveland Indians from 1946 through 1955 and then continued as an announcer. Ralph spent eight decades as a baseball player, executive and broadcaster and was inducted into the hall of fame in 1975.

The memorial also states that Ralph McPherran Kiner from Santa Rita, New Mexico, be recognized as a great New Mexican and for this contributions to baseball and this country. A copy will be sent to the Secretary of Cultural Affairs, the governor and the New Mexico legislative council.
