Synopsis of Bill

House Memorial 94 thanks Representative Henry “Kiki” Saavedra for his dedication to New Mexico through his long years of service in the House of Representatives and wishing him well in his final retirement. The memorial also declares February 17, 2014 as “Kiki Day in the House.”

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

The memorial states that Representative Henry Kiki Saavedra came to the legislature in 1977 for the thirty-third legislature to represent district 10 focusing on improving job opportunities and providing adequate social services as well as improving the criminal justice system. Kiki has been instrumental in building consensus across the isle and crafting many general appropriations acts.

Spending half of his life in the legislature, Representative Saavedra spent time on most of the standing committees as well as interim committees, most notably serving on the Legislative Finance Committee since 1983 and the House Appropriations and Finance Committee since 1989. Kiki has served with distinction in the South Valley caucus and has earned the esteemed

title of “Chairman Emeritus” or “Presidente Emerito,” as well as being considered a model legislator, and the “House Jester.” The memorial also requests that Representative Saavedra come back occasionally to visit and lighten the mood.
