### SUMMARY

#### Synopsis of Bill

Senate Bill 22 amends the Compact Negotiation Act, Section 11-13A-4 NMSA 1978, and extends the time allowed for a tribe, nation, or pueblo to enter a gaming compact or amendment to an existing compact. The bill strikes language in Section 11-13A-4 J that requires a tribe, nation, or pueblo submit a request to the governor to enter the 2001 compact, 2007 compact, or amendments to either, within 240 days following the date the tribe first executes an amendment to either compact.

### FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

SB 22 does not include an appropriation. There may be impacts on tribal revenue sharing agreements depending on whether current compact tribes submit a request to enter another compact or amended compact.
