#### Synopsis of SEC Amendment

The Senate Education Committee amendment to Senate Joint Memorial 11 removed the request “that a copy of this memorial be transmitted to keep the promise for New Mexico's future” from SJM 11.

#### Synopsis of Original Bill

Senate Joint Memorial 11 recognizes the community vision and need for a high-quality, inclusive, and equitable public education system in New Mexico. The joint memorial also resolves that the Legislature renew its commitment to New Mexico students, families, educators and communities to focus resources and craft policies in a manner that moves New Mexico toward the shared vision of a high-quality public education for all.
