#### Synopsis of SFI Amendment

Senate Floor amendment #1 to Senate Memorial 81 adds "Left Turn Distilling" to the list of breweries included in "The Brewery District."

#### Synopsis of Original Bill

Senate Memorial 81 designates an area in Albuquerque, New Mexico "The Brewery District."

### FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

No fiscal impact.

### SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

New Mexico boasts over three dozen established microbreweries and brew pubs. The establishment and growth of breweries has a revitalization effect on surrounding neighborhoods. Nexus, La Cumbre and Il Vicino breweries are located in and around the region north of Candelaria road, west of the north diversion channel, east of Interstate 25, and south of Jefferson. SM 81 refers to and brands this area as "The Brewery District."

A copy of SM 81 will be sent to the owners of Nexus, La Cumbre, Left Turn Distilling, and Il Vicino breweries.
