10 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION  
11 ADOPTING A JOINT RULE TO REQUIRE THE WEBCASTING OF INTERIM  
12 COMMITTEE MEETINGS.

14 WHEREAS, Legislative Joint Rule 8-1 provides for the  
15 adoption, amendment or repeal of joint rules by concurrent  
16 resolution approved by two-thirds of the membership of each  
17 house;

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF  
19 REPRESENTATIVES, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN, that the  
20 following new proposed Joint Rule 13-1 be adopted to read:

21 "INTERIM COMMITTEE MEETING WEBCASTING (13-1)

22 A. Live video and audio streams of  
23 interim committee proceedings shall be accessible  
24 through the legislature's web site; provided that  
25 the availability of streams of committee proceedings

1 held outside of the capitol shall be subject to the  
2 financial and technical capabilities of the  
3 legislative council service.

4 B. A stream shall begin as soon as  
5 practicable after the chair has called the meeting  
6 to order and shall terminate as soon as practicable  
7 after the committee has recessed or adjourned or  
8 upon order of the chair. The streams shall be  
9 archived.

10 C. A stream shall carry a notice to the  
11 effect that the stream is being produced for the  
12 benefit of the public and any political use is  
13 prohibited and that the stream is not an official  
14 record of the committee's or legislature's  
15 proceedings."
