AN ACT

RELATING TO LICENSURE; AMENDING THE DEFINITIONS OF
"ANESTHESIOLOGIST" AND "ANESTHESIOLOGIST ASSISTANT" IN THE
ANESTHESIOLOGIST ASSISTANTS ACT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 61-6-10.2 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2001,
Chapter 311, Section 2, as amended by Laws 2003, Chapter 19,
Section 11 and by Laws 2003, Chapter 302, Section 1) is amended
to read:

"61-6-10.2. DEFINITIONS.--As used in the Anesthesiologist
Assistants Act:

A. "anesthesiologist" means a physician licensed to
practice medicine in New Mexico who has successfully completed
an accredited anesthesiology graduate medical education
program, who is board certified by the American board of

1 anesthesia or board eligible and who has completed a
2 residency in anesthesia within the last three years or who
3 has foreign certification determined by the board to be the
4 substantial equivalent [~~and who is an employee of the~~
5 ~~department of anesthesia of a medical school in New~~

7 B. "anesthesiologist assistant" means a skilled
8 person [~~employed or to be employed by a university in New~~
9 ~~Mexico with a medical school~~] certified by the board as being
10 qualified by academic and practical training to assist an
11 anesthesiologist in developing and implementing anesthesia care
12 plans for patients under the supervision and direction of the
13 anesthesiologist who is responsible for the performance of that
14 anesthesiologist assistant;

15 C. "applicant" means a person who is applying to
16 the board for a license as an anesthesiologist assistant;

17 D. "board" means the New Mexico medical board; and

18 E. "license" means an authorization to practice as
19 an anesthesiologist assistant."
