(1) "charitable organization" means an organization, not for pecuniary profit, that is operated for the relief of poverty, distress or other condition of public concern in New Mexico and that has been granted an exemption from federal income tax as an organization described in Section 501(c) of the United States Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended or renumbered;

8 (2) "chartered branch, lodge or chapter of a 9 national or state organization" means a branch, lodge or 10 chapter that is a civic or service organization, not for 11 pecuniary profit, and that is authorized by its written 12 constitution, charter, articles of incorporation or bylaws to 13 engage in a fraternal, civic or service purpose in New Mexico;

(3) "educational organization" means an organization within the state, including recognized student organizations, not for pecuniary profit, whose primary purpose is educational in nature and designed to develop the capabilities of individuals by instruction;

(4) "environmental organization" means an organization within the state, not organized for pecuniary profit, that is primarily concerned with the protection and preservation of the natural environment;

(5) "fraternal organization" means an organization within the state, not for pecuniary profit, that is a branch, lodge or chapter of a national or state .199970.1
