AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH CARE; ENACTING A NEW SECTION OF THE PHARMACY ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF UNUSED DANGEROUS DRUGS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. A new section of the Pharmacy Act is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] DANGEROUS DRUG TAKE-BACK PROGRAM--
RULEMAKING.--

A. In consultation with the environmental improvement board and the federal drug enforcement administration, the board of pharmacy shall adopt and promulgate rules to establish a dangerous drug take-back program that will:

- (1) require each retail pharmacy in the state

1 to collect unused dangerous drugs;

2 (2) provide for the safe disposal of the
3 dangerous drugs in accordance with state and federal law; and

4 (3) indemnify and hold harmless wholesale drug
5 distributors for actions taken in compliance with the dangerous
6 drug take-back program that the board of pharmacy establishes
7 pursuant to this section.

8 B. The board of pharmacy shall establish a means of
9 funding, and may impose a reasonable fee, to cover costs of
10 executing the provisions of this section."
