AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO SUPPORT PROGRAMS THAT PROVIDE
SERVICES TO URBAN INDIANS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.--Two hundred ten thousand
dollars (\$210,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the
Indian affairs department for expenditure in fiscal year 2016
to support programs that provide services and promote wellness,
education and self-sufficiency to Albuquerque's urban Indians.
Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of
fiscal year 2016 shall revert to the general fund.
