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14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

15 SECTION 1. A new section of the State Rules Act is
16 enacted to read:

17 "[NEW MATERIAL] EXPIRATION OF RULES--EXCEPTIONS.--Except
18 for rules adopted by the taxation and revenue department, on
19 July 1, 2020, all rules shall expire. Thereafter, any rule
20 that is adopted shall expire on July 1 five years from the
21 calendar year in which the rule was published in the New Mexico
22 register, and the rule shall not be re-filed with the records
23 center unless, prior to the expiration date, the issuing agency
24 conducts a review of the rule to eliminate the rule if found to
25 be no longer applicable, cost-effective, timely or necessary

1 for the implementation of the agency's mission as provided by
2 law. Nothing in this section shall be construed to preclude an
3 agency from holding a public hearing regarding a rule if the
4 agency deems the hearing necessary as part of the review of the
5 rule. The provisions of this section do not apply to a rule
6 adopted and filed within two years of the rule's expiration
7 date."

8 SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the
9 provisions of this act is July 1, 2015.

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
