AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTORCYCLES; REQUIRING THE USE OF SAFETY HELMETS FOR ALL MOTORCYCLE OPERATORS AND PASSENGERS; PRESCRIBING A PENALTY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 66-7-356 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1978, Chapter 35, Section 460, as amended) is amended to read:

"66-7-356. MANDATORY USE OF PROTECTIVE HELMETS.--

A. [No] A person [under the age of eighteen shall operate] who operates a motorcycle [unless he is wearing] shall wear a safety helmet that is securely fastened on [his] the person's head in a normal manner as headgear and [meeting] that meets the standards specified by the director. The director shall adopt rules and regulations establishing standards [covering the types of] and specifications for acceptable

helmets [and the specifications therefor] and shall establish
and maintain a list of approved helmets meeting [the] those
standards and specifications [of the director. No]. \underline{A} dealer
or person who leases or rents motorcycles shall <u>not</u> lease or
rent a motorcycle to a person [under the age of eighteen]
unless the lessee or renter shows such person a valid driver's
license or permit and possesses the safety equipment required
of an operator [who is under the age of eighteen. No]. \underline{A}
person shall <u>not</u> carry any passenger [under the age of
eighteen] on any motorcycle unless the passenger is wearing a
securely fastened safety helmet, as specified in this section,
meeting the standards specified by the director.

- B. Failure to wear a safety helmet as required in this section shall not constitute contributory negligence."
- SECTION 2. Section 66-8-116 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1978, Chapter 35, Section 524, as amended) is amended to read:
- "66-8-116. PENALTY ASSESSMENT MISDEMEANORS-DEFINITION--SCHEDULE OF ASSESSMENTS.--
- A. As used in the Motor Vehicle Code, "penalty assessment misdemeanor" means violation of any of the following listed sections of the NMSA 1978 for which, except as provided in Subsections D and E of this section, the listed penalty assessment is established:

- B. The term "penalty assessment misdemeanor" does not include a violation that has caused or contributed to the cause of an accident resulting in injury or death to a person.
- C. When an alleged violator of a penalty assessment misdemeanor elects to accept a notice to appear in lieu of a notice of penalty assessment, a fine imposed upon later conviction shall not exceed the penalty assessment established for the particular penalty assessment misdemeanor and probation imposed upon a suspended or deferred sentence shall not exceed ninety days.
- D. The penalty assessment for speeding in violation of Paragraph (4) of Subsection A of Section 66-7-301 NMSA 1978 is twice the penalty assessment established in Subsection A of this section for the equivalent miles per hour over the speed limit.
- E. Upon a second conviction for operation without a .199246.3

permit for excessive size or weight pursuant to Section 66-7-413 NMSA 1978, the penalty assessment shall be two hundred fifty dollars (\$250). Upon a third or subsequent conviction, the penalty assessment shall be five hundred dollars (\$500).

F. Upon a second conviction for transport of a reducible load with a permit for excessive size or weight pursuant to Subsection N of Section 66-7-413 NMSA 1978 more than six miles from a port-of-entry facility on the border with Mexico, the penalty assessment shall be five hundred dollars (\$500). Upon a third or subsequent conviction, the penalty assessment shall be one thousand dollars (\$1,000)."

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the provisions of this act is July 1, 2015.
