2 DECLARING JANUARY 27, 2015 "SENIOR CITIZENS DAY" IN THE  
3 SENATE.

18 such as those provided through the alliance for area  
19 agencies on aging and the aging network that are  
20 instrumental in allowing senior citizens of New Mexico to  
21 live independently and with dignity for as long as possible  
22 by joining together in one unified voice through advocacy  
23 and education to ensure continued access to, and excellence  
24 of, services that meet the needs and enrich the lives of  
25 senior citizens and persons with disabilities;

1           NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE  
2 STATE OF NEW MEXICO that January 27, 2015 be declared  
3 "Senior Citizens Day" in the senate; and

4           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this memorial  
5 be transmitted to the aging and long-term services
