2 RECOGNIZING THE UNIVERSITY OF NEW MEXICO COLLEGE OF NURSING
3 FOR EDUCATING NURSES AND PROMOTING THE HEALTH AND WELL-BEING
4 OF NEW MEXICANS FOR SIXTY YEARS AND DECLARING
5 FEBRUARY 13, 2015 "UNIVERSITY OF NEW MEXICO COLLEGE OF
6 NURSING DAY" IN THE SENATE.

8 WHEREAS, since 1955, the university of New Mexico
9 college of nursing has worked to educate nurses, awarding
10 almost six thousand degrees in nursing; and

11 WHEREAS, the university of New Mexico college of
12 nursing is committed to ensuring that New Mexicans have
13 access to quality health care provided by advanced practice
14 nurses by establishing a diverse array of faculty practices
15 and clinical education partnerships; and

16 WHEREAS, the university of New Mexico college of
17 nursing's mission is to promote health through the discovery
18 and communication of knowledge to enhance the art and
19 science of nursing through excellence in education,
20 research, scholarship and service; and

21 WHEREAS, the university of New Mexico college of
22 nursing has partnered with other state-funded nursing
23 programs across the state to create a common core curriculum
24 in nursing education, transforming the current structure
25 into an efficient and easily accessible baccalaureate

1 program for students;

2 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE
3 STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the faculty and staff of the
4 university of New Mexico college of nursing be recognized
5 for their outstanding work in educating nurses and in
6 promoting health care throughout New Mexico; and

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that February 13, 2015 be
8 declared "University of New Mexico College of Nursing Day"
9 in the Senate; and

10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this memorial be
11 transmitted to the dean of the university of New Mexico
12 college of nursing. _____
