#### SUMMARY

#### Synopsis of Bill

House Bill 150 would allow qualified electors to register to vote at any early voting center during primary and general elections. HB 150 requires a person to vote on a provisional ballot if: the person is not registered, or is not registered in the correct precinct; attempts to register to vote at an early voting site but the site does not have real-time access to the statewide electronic voter file; and would otherwise be eligible to vote at the early voting site.

#### FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

Unknown. The entities required to provide early voting services (county clerks) and pay election costs (SOS) did not respond to the request for analysis.
