SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

House Bill 252 would require voter registration to be made available at all public post-secondary educational institutions.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The SOS would not incur a cost as a result of enactment of HB 252 unless the SOS had to provide paper registration forms to the institutions. The SOS reports the cost of 100 paper forms to be \$32.66.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

The SOS notes that the Human Services Department currently provides individuals with voter registration forms in information packets produced by HSD. Additionally, the Motor Vehicle Division prints voter registration forms for customers. The SOS does not incur any costs for voter registration forms provided by HSD and MVD.
