Synopsis of Bill

House Joint Memorial 15 asks that the Higher Education Department (HED) be requested to form a task force to study minority representation in the faculties of social work, sociology and psychology programs in public colleges and universities in New Mexico. HED shall appoint members of the task force who represent the Office on African American Affairs, the National Hispanic Cultural Center, the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People, the University of New Mexico Native American Studies Department, the all Indian pueblo council, the New Mexico Alliance for Hispanic Education, and the Southwest Research Institute. The task force shall further include a dean or department head and a faculty member from each school, college or department of social work, sociology and psychology.
