## **SUMMARY**

### Synopsis of Bill

Senate Bill 125 lowers the maximum speed limit for county roads without a posted speed limit from 75 miles per hour to 55 miles per hour and corrects all references to the department of transportation.

### FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

There is no fiscal impact associated with this bill.

### SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

DOT states the condition of county roads across the state varies greatly with topography, and population density and many roads are not appropriate for even a 55 mph speed limit, given design guidelines for stopping and sight distance, roadway geometry, and roadside safety. A speed study should always be performed on roads where conditions are not expected to meet current design standards for a 55 mph speed.
