SUMMARY

Synopsis of House Agriculture, Water, and Wildlife Committee Amendment

House Agriculture, Water, and Wildlife Committee Amendment to Senate Bill 398 states the board of county commissioners shall cause the order prohibiting the running at large of livestock to be published once each week for four consecutive weeks in a newspaper published in the county where the petition has been filed.

Synopsis of Original Bill

Senate Bill 398 amends Section 77-14-6 NMSA 1978 to say the board of county commissioners may make an order prohibiting the running at large of livestock within the limits of the platted townsite and platted addition within the limits of the conservancy or irrigation districts or within the limits of the military reservation or enclave. Currently, the section states "the board of county commissioners shall make an order..."

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

There are no identified fiscal implications.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

According to NMLB, making this change from shall to may gives the board of county commissioners the authority to conform to fence out laws in Section 77-16-1 NMSA 1978, estray laws in Section 77-13-2 NMSA 1978, and to be in compliance with property laws pertaining to county subdivisions in Section 47-6-9 NMSA 1978.
