SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

Senate Bill 444 appropriates \$250 thousand from the general fund to the Local Government Division of the Department of Finance and Administration (LGD of DFA) for expenditure in FY16 for the Mid-Region Council of Governments to contract with a community-based organization to develop and implement educational career cohorts made up of persons seeking alternative licensure for careers as bilingual math and science teachers and teachers of science, technology, engineering, mathematics, special education, career-technical education and early childhood education.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The appropriation of \$250 thousand contained in this bill is a recurring expense to the general

fund. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of FY16 shall revert to the general fund.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

Generally, bills containing location-specific appropriations may be in violation of the Antidonation Clause of the New Mexico Constitution or at risk for veto.
