Synopsis of Bill

Senate Bill 603 amends the language within Section 21-4-2 NMSA 1978 to change the name of common convenience of the Northern New Mexico State School from “Northern New Mexico College (NNMC) to “Northern New Mexico University” (NNMU).

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

No fiscal impact.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

In 2005, the New Mexico Legislature changed the name of the Northern New Mexico State School to “Northern New Mexico College” (NNMC) for common convenience.

ADMINISTRATIVE IMPLICATIONS

Northern New Mexico College would be responsible for implementing its name change to Northern New Mexico University for common convenience
