19	A. Qualification of a person as blind shall be
20	determined by means of an eye examination by a licensed
21	ophthalmologist or a licensed optometrist. Blindness shall be
22	the major handicap in cases of multiple handicaps. Persons who
23	are not blind but who have been certified by a licensed
24	ophthalmologist <u>or a licensed optometrist</u> as suffering from a
25	deteriorating condition [ <del>which</del> ] <u>that</u> will result in blindness

2	B. The commission <u>for the blind</u> shall determine the
3	procedure to be followed for the examination of any person to
4	establish blindness and shall maintain a list of all
5	ophthalmologists and optometrists currently licensed in New
6	Mexico. The person may choose any licensed ophthalmologist <u>or</u>
7	licensed optometrist to make the examination and the cost shall
8	be paid by the commission pursuant to its regulations."
