AN ACT

RELATING TO LEGISLATORS; SPECIFYING LEAVE REQUIREMENTS FOR
LEGISLATORS EMPLOYED BY POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS OF THE STATE
WHEN CONDUCTING LEGISLATIVE BUSINESS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. A new section of Chapter 2, Article 1 NMSA
1978 is enacted to read:

"~~[NEW MATERIAL]~~ LEGISLATORS AS EMPLOYEES OF POLITICAL
SUBDIVISIONS--ACCRUED ANNUAL OR COMPENSATORY LEAVE.--

A. A legislator who is an employee of a political
subdivision of the state shall take accrued annual or
compensatory leave or leave without pay on a day that the
legislator attends a meeting for which the legislator is
eligible to receive per diem pursuant to Article 4, Section 10
of the constitution of New Mexico.
