12 1978 TO PROVIDE FOR A MINIMUM HOURLY WAGE RATE OF TEN DOLLARS
13 TEN CENTS (\$10.10) FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE STATE AND STATE
14 EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

17 SECTION 1. Section 10-7-9 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1974,
18 Chapter 10, Section 2) is amended to read:

19 "10-7-9. MINIMUM SALARY RATE.--Every state employee and
20 every person regularly employed at a state educational
21 institution named in Article 12, Section 11 of the constitution
22 of New Mexico [~~constitution~~], except student employees as
23 defined by the [~~board of educational finance~~] higher education
24 department, shall receive a salary [~~at a rate equal to at least~~
25 ~~four hundred dollars (\$400) per month~~] calculable at no less
