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11	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:	
12	SECTION 1. SESSION EXPENSES	
13	A. There is appropriated from the general fund for	
14	the expense of the legislative department of the state of New	
15	Mexico for the second session of the fifty-second legislature	
16	for per diem and mileage of its members, for salaries of	
17	employees and for other expenses of the legislature, five	
18	million three hundred eighty-five thousand two hundred	
19	dollars (\$5,385,200) or so much thereof as may be necessary	
20	for such purposes.	
21	B. The expenditures referred to in Subsection A of	
22	this section are as follows:	
23	(1) per diem for senators\$ 205,380;	
24	(2) per diem for members of the house of

23	legislative switchboard, seven hundred fifteen thousand five		
24	hundred dollars (\$715,500) to be disbursed upon vouchers		
25	signed by the director of the legislative council service or		

1 the director's designee.

2 C. The expenditures for the senate shall be 3 disbursed on vouchers signed by the chair of the committees' committee and the chief clerk of the senate or the chief 4 clerk's designee. The expenditures for the house of 5 representatives shall be disbursed on vouchers signed by the 6 speaker and chief clerk of the house or the chief clerk's 7 designee. Following adjournment of the session, expenditures 8 authorized pursuant to Paragraphs (1) through (8) of 9 Subsection B of this section shall be disbursed upon vouchers 10 signed by the director of the legislative council service or 11 the director's designee. 12

D. Under the printing contracts entered into for 13 the second session of the fifty-second legislature, the chair 14 of the committees' committee of the senate, subject to the 15 approval of the committee, and the speaker of the house of 16 representatives are authorized and directed to provide for 17 the printing of all bills, resolutions, joint resolutions, 18 memorials and joint memorials introduced in the senate or 19 house, the printing of the weekly bill locator and the 20 printing of all necessary stationery required for use in the 21 respective houses. They are further directed to provide for 22 the purchase of all supplies necessary for use in the 23 respective houses within the appropriation provided. The 24 orders for printing, stationery and supplies shall be 25

approved by the chair of the committees' committee in the 1 senate or by the speaker of the house. 2 SECTION 2. BILLS AND OTHER PRINTED MATERIALS.--3 A. For the second session of the fifty-second 4 legislature, bills, resolutions, joint resolutions, memorials 5 6 and joint memorials delivered to the printer shall be returned by the printer to the joint billroom within forty-7 two hours after they are ordered to be printed. The billroom 8 personnel shall supply a complete file of bills, resolutions, 9 joint resolutions, memorials, joint memorials and other 10 printed distribution materials to the following: 11 (1) one copy to each member of the house of 12 representatives and the senate; 13 (2) upon written request, one copy to each 14 county clerk, district judge, radio or television station and 15 newspaper and to the general library of each state-supported 16 institution of higher learning; and 17 (3) upon written request, one copy to each 18 state department, commission, board, institution or agency, 19 each elected state official, each incorporated municipality, 20 each district attorney, each ex-governor, each member of the 21 New Mexico congressional delegation and each public school 22 district in the state. 23 B. Any person not listed in Subsection A of this 24

section may secure a complete file of the bills, resolutions,

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joint resolutions, memorials and joint memorials of the 1 2 legislature by depositing with the legislative council 3 service the amount of three hundred seventy-five dollars (\$375), which deposit shall be paid to the state treasurer to 4 the credit of the legislative expense fund. Additional 5 single copies of items of legislation shall be sold for two 6 dollars (\$2.00) unless the director of the legislative 7 council service shall, because of its length, assign a higher 8 price not to exceed ten cents (\$.10) per page. Copies of a 9 daily bill locator, other than those copies furnished to each 10 member of the respective houses, shall be supplied by the 11 legislative council service at a charge of one hundred 12 twenty-five dollars (\$125) for the entire session. 13 **SECTION 3.** LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL SERVICE.--There is 14 appropriated from the general fund to the legislative council 15 service for fiscal year 2017 unless otherwise indicated, to 16 be disbursed on vouchers signed by the director of the 17 legislative council service, the following: 18 A. Personal Services & 19 \$ 4,673,700 Employee Benefits 20 Contractual Services 235,000 21 1,169,500 Other Costs 22 \$ 6,078,200; Total 23 B. for travel expenses of legislators other than 24 New Mexico legislative council members, on legislative 25
