10	A. Officers elected or appointed in a county of
11	the H class to an office that is designated as part-time
12	shall receive no more than the following annual salaries:
13	(1) county commissioners, thirteen thousand
14	seven hundred seventy-seven dollars (\$13,777);
15	(2) treasurer, six thousand eight hundred
16	eighty-nine dollars (\$6,889);
17	(3) assessor, six thousand eight hundred
18	eighty-nine dollars (\$6,889);
19	(4) sheriff, six thousand eight hundred
20	eighty-nine dollars (\$6,889);
21	(5) county clerk, six thousand eight hundred
22	eighty-nine dollars (\$6,889); and
23	(6) probate judge, four thousand thirty-one
24	dollars (\$4,031).
25	B. Officers who are elected or appointed in a
