11	MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR SERVICES FOR SENIOR CITIZENS
12	THROUGHOUT NEW MEXICO.

14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
15	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION
16	A. The following amounts are appropriated from the
17	general fund to the aging and long-term services department for
18	expenditure in fiscal year 2018 to fund the following programs
19	and services:
20	(1) one million two hundred fifty-seven
21	thousand, nine hundred ninety-eight dollars (\$1,257,998) for
22	the following senior services delivered through the four area
23	agencies on aging:
24	(a) adult day care;
25	(b) case management;

1	(c) congregate meals;
2	(d) home-delivered meals;
3	(e) in-home services;
4	(f) transportation; and
5	(g) senior center services;
6	(2) one hundred three thousand dollars
7	(\$103,000) for volunteer programs, including foster
8	grandparents, senior companions and retired senior volunteers;
9	(3) thirty-four thousand dollars (\$34,000) to
10	fund evidence-based Alzheimer's programming in northern New
11	Mexico; and
12	(4) thirty-six thousand dollars (\$36,000) to
13	fund competitive athletic and fitness programming for seniors.
14	B. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining
15	at the end of fiscal year 2018 shall revert to the general
16	fund.
