AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH; REQUIRING THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO ENTER INTO INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENTS WITH NEW MEXICO INDIAN NATIONS, TRIBES AND PUEBLOS THAT PARTICIPATE IN THE STATE'S MEDICAL CANNABIS PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. A new section of the Lynn and Erin Compassionate Use Act is enacted to read:

"~~[NEW MATERIAL]~~ INDIAN NATIONS, TRIBES AND PUEBLOS-- INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENTS.--The department shall enter into an intergovernmental agreement with any sovereign Indian nation, tribe or pueblo located in New Mexico that elects to implement the provisions of the medical cannabis program established pursuant to the Lynn and Erin Compassionate Use Act. The intergovernmental agreement shall provide for:
