16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
17	SECTION 1. A new section of Chapter 35, Article 7 NMSA
18	1978 is enacted to read:
19	"[<u>NEW MATERIAL</u>] MAGISTRATE COURTS OPERATIONS FUNDThe
20	"magistrate courts operations fund" is created in the state
21	treasury. The fund consists of magistrate courts operations
22	fees collected pursuant to Section 66-8-116.3 NMSA 1978 and any
23	appropriations, gifts, grants and donations. Income from the
24	fund shall be credited to the fund. Money in the fund at the
25	end of a fiscal year shall not revert to any other fund. The

Money in the fund shall be disbursed on warrants signed by the secretary of finance and administration pursuant to vouchers signed by the director of the administrative office of the courts or the director's authorized representative."

SECTION 2. Section 66-8-116.3 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1989, Chapter 318, Section 35 and Laws 1989, Chapter 319, Section 14 and also Laws 1989, Chapter 320, Section 5, as amended) is amended to read:

"66-8-116.3. PENALTY ASSESSMENT MISDEMEANORS--ADDITIONAL FEES.--In addition to the penalty assessment established for each penalty assessment misdemeanor, there shall be assessed:

A. in a county without a metropolitan court, twenty dollars (\$20.00) to help defray the costs of local government corrections;
