15	medical examination of a sexual assault victim for that
16	laboratory. The bureau may charge a laboratory that the bureau
17	assists as provided in this subsection a fee of up to eight
18	hundred dollars (\$800) for each sexual assault examination kit
19	that the bureau processes and tests. Fees collected by the
20	bureau in accordance with this subsection shall be deposited in
21	the sexual assault examination kit fund.

1 FUND.--The "sexual assault examination kit fund" is created in 2 the state treasury. The fund consists of fees paid to the 3 department of public safety for the testing of sexual assault 4 examination kits, income from investment of the fund and money 5 otherwise accruing to the fund. Money in the fund shall not revert to any other fund at the end of a fiscal year. 6 The 7 department of public safety shall administer the fund, and money in the fund is appropriated to the department of public 8 safety for expenses related to the testing of sexual assault 9 10 examination kits in accordance with Subsection B of Section 29-3-4 NMSA 1978.
