I request that the following be funded:

• to the office of the state engineer

#### FARMINGTON VILLA VIEW STORM DRAINAGE FACILITY

two million four hundred fifty-five thousand nine hundred two dollars (\$2,455,902) to acquire land for and to plan, design and construct the Villa View storm drainage detention facility, including detention ponds and related infrastructure, in Farmington in San Juan county

• to the department of environment

#### FARMINGTON ZONE 2P WATERLINE CONSTRUCT

nine million nine hundred twenty-seven thousand two hundred ninety-seven dollars (\$9,927,297) to plan, design and construct the zone 2P water line in Farmington in San Juan county

• to the local government division of the department of finance and administration

### FARMINGTON ANIMAS RIVER TRAIL & BRIDGES

four million dollars (\$4,000,000) to acquire land and water rights for and to plan, design, construct and furnish walking trails and bridges along the Animas river in Farmington in San Juan county

• to the department of transportation

#### FOOTHILLS DR IMPROVE FARMINGTON

two million five hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$2,575,000) to acquire rights of way for and plan, design and construct improvements to Foothills drive, including lanes, a roundabout, bicycle lanes and an accessible pedestrian path, in Farmington in San Juan county

#### MAIN ST IMPROVE FARMINGTON

five million dollars (\$5,000,000) to acquire rights of way for and plan, design and construct improvements to lanes, sidewalks, curbs, gutters, drainage and intersections, including the addition of roundabouts and parking, on Main street in Farmington in San Juan county

## PINON HILLS BLVD EXTENSION FARMINGTON

twenty-two million three hundred seventy-two thousand three hundred seventy-six dollars (\$22,372,376) to plan, design and construct a bridge and extension of Pinon Hills boulevard in Farmington in San Juan county
