fifty thousand dollars ( $\$ 50,000$ ) to plan, design and construct improvements to water, wastewater, natural gas and electric lines in Navajo in the Red Lake chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

THOREAU CHP VETERANS SERVICE CTR CONSTRUCT
three hundred thousand dollars $(\$ 300,000)$ to plan, design and construct a veterans service center in the Thoreau chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

## ROCK SPRINGS CHP MULTIPURPOSE CENTER CONSTRUCT

five hundred thousand dollars $(\$ 500,000)$ to plan, design, construct, furnish and equip a multipurpose center in the Rock Springs chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county
