6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
7	SECTION 1. Section 5-17-2 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2009,
8	Chapter 136, Section 2) is amended to read:
9	"5-17-2. DEFINITIONSAs used in the Infrastructure
10	Development Zone Act:
11	A. "approving authority" means the governing body
12	required by Section 5-17-9 or 5-17-13 NMSA 1978 to designate
13	an election official to conduct the organization election and
14	exercise other duties pursuant to the Infrastructure
15	Development Zone Act;
16	B. "board" means the board of directors of an
17	infrastructure development zone;
18	C. "director" means a member of a board;
19	D. "eligible elector" means a person who is
20	registered to vote in New Mexico and who:
21	(1) has been a resident of the
22	infrastructure development zone or the area to be included in
23	the infrastructure development zone for not less than thirty
24	days; or
25	(2) is a taxpaying elector;

- E. "governing body" means the governing body of a municipality or the board of county commissioners of a county;
- F. "infrastructure development zone" means a political subdivision organized or acting pursuant to the provisions of the Infrastructure Development Zone Act;
- G. "publication" means printing one time, in one newspaper of general circulation in the infrastructure development zone or proposed infrastructure development zone if there is such a newspaper, and, if not, then in a newspaper in the county in which the infrastructure development zone or proposed infrastructure development zone is located. If an infrastructure development zone has territory within more than one county and if publication cannot be made in one newspaper of general circulation in the infrastructure development zone, then one publication is required in a newspaper in each county in which the infrastructure development zone is located and in which the infrastructure development zone also has fifty or more eligible electors;
- H. "regular election" means the election on the Tuesday succeeding the first Monday of May in every even-numbered year, held for the purpose of electing members to the board and for submission of other questions, if any;
 - I. "secretary" means the secretary of a board;

-	3. Services means any improvements and
2	facilities listed in this subsection and provided for in the
3	service plan of an infrastructure development zone as
4	approved by the governing body, including both on-site
5	improvements and off-site improvements that directly or
6	indirectly benefit the infrastructure development zone and
7	necessary or incidental work, whether newly constructed,
8	renovated or existing, and all necessary or desirable
9	appurtenances. "Services" include:
10	(1) sanitary sewage systems, including
11	collection, transport, storage, treatment, dispersal,
12	effluent use and discharge;
13	(2) drainage and flood control systems,
14	including collection, transport, diversion, storage,
15	detention, retention, dispersal, use and discharge;
16	(3) water systems for domestic, commercial,
17	office, industrial, irrigation, municipal, fire protection or
18	other purposes, including production, collection, storage,
19	treatment, transport, delivery, connection and dispersal;
20	(4) highways, streets, roadways, bridges,
21	crossing structures and parking facilities, including all
22	areas for vehicular use for travel, ingress, egress and
23	parking;

(5) trails and areas for pedestrian,

equestrian, bicycle or other nonmotor vehicle use for travel,

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-	ingless, egless and parking,
2	(6) pedestrian malls, parks, recreational
3	facilities and open space areas for the use of members of the
4	public for entertainment, assembly and recreation, including
5	programming events for the community and public;
6	(7) landscaping, including earthworks,
7	structures, lakes and other water features, plants, trees and
8	related water delivery systems;
9	(8) public buildings, public safety
10	facilities and fire protection and police facilities, subject
11	to the consent of the approving authority;
12	(9) electrical and energy generation,
13	transmission and distribution facilities, including solar,
14	wind and geothermal;
15	(10) natural gas distribution facilities;
16	(ll) lighting systems;
17	(12) cable or other telecommunications lines
18	and related equipment, including fiber optic transmission
19	facilities designed to carry communication signals such as
20	voice, data and video and any broadband technology
21	infrastructure;
22	(13) traffic control systems and devices,
23	including signals, controls, markings and signage;
24	(14) public educational or cultural
25	facilities;

1	(15) equipment, vehicles, furnishings and
2	other personalty related to the items listed in this
3	subsection;
4	(16) inspection, construction management and
5	program management costs; and
6	(17) solid waste and garbage collection and
7	disposal; and
8	K. "taxpaying elector" means a person:
9	(1) who, or whose spouse, owns taxable real
10	or personal property within the infrastructure development
11	zone or the area to be included in or excluded from the
12	infrastructure development zone, whether the person resides
13	within the infrastructure development zone or not; or
14	(2) who is obligated to pay taxes under a
15	contract to purchase taxable property within the
16	infrastructure development zone or the area to be included in
17	or excluded from the infrastructure development zone, whether
18	the person resides within the infrastructure development zone
19	or not." SB 24
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
