16 forensic science and a professional certificate in forensic  
17 science and advanced investigation from the university of  
18 New Haven in West Haven, Connecticut, in 1991, immediately

21 professionals like John F. Krebsbach that the people's faith  
22 in government will be restored; and

23 WHEREAS, Mr. Krebsbach retired in December and will  
24 rightfully spend well-deserved time with his family;
