Synopsis of House Memorial 124

House Memorial 124 requests an interim study for the use of ignition interlock driver's licenses to identify the holder as a person who is prohibited from purchasing alcoholic beverages

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

HM 124 requests the Department of Public Safety, Taxation and Revenue Department, and the appropriate legislative interim committee to participate in the study. The study will require staff assistance of the three agencies identified. Minimal costs associated with the study could be absorbed by the agencies operating budgets.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

Given the statistics related to DWI, HM 124 indicates the legislature continues to look at ways to address the increasing numbers of DWIs and keep repeat offenders off the highways.

ADMINISTRATIVE IMPLICATIONS

HM 124 does not indicate a time frame as to when the study will be completed and presented.
