SUMMARY

Synopsis of SEC Amendment

The Senate Education Committee amendment to SB406 removes CYFD from the purpose of the appropriation, thus the purpose is to train public school administrators on reporting allegations of sexual assault.

Synopsis of Original Bill

Senate Bill 406 appropriates \$100 thousand from the general fund to the Public Education Department for the purpose of training public school administrators on reporting allegations of sexual assault to the Children, Youth and Families Department.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The appropriation of \$100 thousand contained in this bill is a recurring expense to the general fund. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of FY18 shall revert to the general fund.
