### SUMMARY

#### Synopsis of Amendment

The Senate Rules Committee amendment requires GSD to review the appropriateness of a public facility named for a person convicted of a felony, and to adopt rules for the naming of facilities.

#### Synopsis of Bill

Senate Bill 434 identifies a process for the naming of GSD facilities by the governor.

### SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

Below is a summary of the process with regards to the naming of GSD facilities:

- No public building will be named for a public official during their term in office.
- No public building will be named after a person convicted of a felony.
- Any public building named for a person not a public officer at the time of the naming, may continue to bear that name if the person later becomes a public officer.
- Any public building named for a public officer may continue to bear that name,

- unless that officer is convicted of a felony at which time the building will be renamed.
- The GSD secretary will appoint a naming committee to gather names for public facilities under its jurisdiction, for the secretary and the governor's consideration.
