Synopsis of Bill

House Bill 5 appropriates money from the general fund, other revenue, internal services funds/interagency transfers, and federal funds for FY18, for the operations of legislative agencies and higher education institutions, including the New Mexico School for the Blind and Visually Impaired, New Mexico School for the Deaf, and New Mexico Military Institute.

Recurring general fund appropriations total \$764.7 million, a decrease of \$6.4 million, or 0.8 percent, from the adjusted FY17 level.

With the exception of the University of New Mexico Cancer Center (UNMCC), all recurring appropriations to higher education institutions are reduced 1 percent. The UNMCC receives a \$975 thousand, or 39.1 percent, increase.

Nonrecurring general fund appropriations for special and supplemental items total \$3.3 million.

House Bill 5 - Page 2

The largest of these is a \$2 million special appropriation to the Higher Education Department for student financial aid.

HB 5 provides transfer authority to the Department of Finance and Administration of up to \$2 million from the general fund to the general operating reserves for the State Board of Finance emergency fund.
