AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE HUMAN SERVICES DEPARTMENT TO
FUND THE ESTABLISHMENT, IMPLEMENTATION, DATA ANALYSIS AND
REPORTING PURSUANT TO A DEMONSTRATION PROJECT IN RIO ARRIBA AND
TAOS COUNTIES THAT PROVIDES EVIDENCE-BASED, RESIDENTIAL
SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER TREATMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.--

A. One million four hundred thousand dollars
(\$1,400,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the human
services department for expenditure in fiscal years 2019 and
2020 to fund the establishment, implementation, data analysis
and reporting pursuant to a demonstration project in Rio Arriba
and Taos counties that:

- (1) provides evidence-based, residential

1 substance use disorder treatment of at least one year's
2 duration for each participant with a substance use disorder;

3 (2) tracks participants' ability to remain
4 free of substance use after treatment; and

5 (3) collects and analyzes county statistics on
6 emergency department visits, crime and recidivism in Rio Arriba
7 and Taos counties.

8 B. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining
9 at the end of fiscal year 2020 shall revert to the general
10 fund.
