SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

House Bill 146 appropriates \$250 thousand from the general fund to the Department of Health to fund the provision of cancer survivorship services, including community-based education, practical and emotional support services, and lodging for cancer patients.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The appropriation of \$250 thousand contained in this bill is a recurring expense to the general fund. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of FY19 shall revert to the general fund.
