Synopsis of Bill

Senate Bill 259 appropriates just over \$2 million to the Local Government Division of the Department of Finance and Administration to fund a joint project of the city of Las Vegas and San Miguel county to create a northeastern regional first responders training facility.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The appropriation of two million forty-nine thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,049,500) contained in this bill is a nonrecurring expense to the general fund. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2019 shall revert to the general fund.
