AN ACT

RELATING TO STATE EMPLOYEES; REQUIRING STATE AGENCIES TO ANNUALLY REPORT STATISTICAL DATA ON THE DIVERSITY OF THEIR WORKFORCES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. A new section of Chapter 10 NMSA 1978 is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] DIVERSITY IN STATE GOVERNMENT--COLLECTION OF STATISTICAL DATA.--

A. A state agency, including a department,

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institution, board, bureau, commission or district of the executive, legislative or judicial branch of the state, shall collect and maintain statistical HLVMC→and wage←HLVMC data on the racial, ethnic and gender composition of its workforce, including elected and appointed officers and employees. Each agency shall annually, on or before July 1, provide a report of the statistical data collected to the state personnel office.

B. The state personnel office shall aggregate the statistical data reported by the state agencies pursuant to Subsection A of this section and shall publish the data to the New Mexico sunshine portal website."
