AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF AN ACOMA-KERES LANGUAGE DICTIONARY AND CURRICULUM IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.--Three hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$350,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the HSEIC→public education←HSEIC HSEIC→Indian affairs←HSEIC department for expenditure in fiscal year 2020 to develop the Acoma-Keres language dictionary and curriculum for early childhood through eighth grade education programs.
