BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. [NEW MATERIAL] LICENSED SUBSTANCE ABUSE ASSOCIATES -- MEDICAL ASSISTANCE -- REIMBURSEMENT FOR SERVICES .--The secretary of human services shall adopt and promulgate rules to allow a Sfl→behavioral health agency employing a←Sfl .211574.1

bracketed material] = delete underscored material = new Amendments: new substance abuse associate licensed in accordance with the Counseling and Therapy Practice Act to be reimbursed for the following services provided to medical assistance recipients within the licensed substance abuse associate's scope of practice Sfl-under clinical supervision Sfl:

- A. providing interventions directly to individuals, couples, families and groups;
 - B. employing practice theory and research findings;
- C. providing screening, assessment, consultation, development of treatment plans, case management, counseling, referral, appraisal, crisis intervention, education, reporting or recordkeeping pertaining specifically to alcohol and drug abuse counseling;
- D. providing generalist services in the role of educator, assistant or mediator;
 - E. taking a social history; and
 - F. conducting a home study.

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
