11 RELATING TO MUSEUMS; CREATING ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR  
12 MEMBERS OF THE NEW MEXICO MUSEUM OF SPACE HISTORY COMMISSION.

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14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

15 SECTION 1. Section 18-7-2 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1978,  
16 Chapter 72, Section 2, as amended by Laws 2001, Chapter 275,  
17 Section 3 and by Laws 2001, Chapter 278, Section 3) is amended  
18 to read:

19 "18-7-2. NEW MEXICO MUSEUM OF SPACE HISTORY COMMISSION.--  
20 There is created the "New Mexico museum of space history  
21 commission" consisting of eleven members appointed by the  
22 governor. [~~Four members of the commission shall be appointed~~  
23 ~~at large and one member shall be appointed from each of the~~  
24 ~~planning and development districts.] Membership shall be  
25 composed of geographically diverse residents of the state that~~

1 are proficient in the scientific study of space, museums or  
2 other relevant subject areas. Three members shall be appointed  
3 to the commission for a term ending December 31, 1974, four  
4 members shall be appointed to the commission for a term ending  
5 December 31, 1975 and four members shall be appointed to the  
6 commission for a term ending December 31, 1976. Thereafter,  
7 members of the commission shall be appointed for terms of three  
8 years or less in such manner that the staggered expiration date  
9 is maintained. Necessary officers shall be elected by the  
10 commission. The commission members shall be reimbursed for  
11 their necessary and actual mileage and per diem expenses as  
12 provided in the Per Diem and Mileage Act."
