six hundred thirty-four thousand six hundred twenty-five dollars (\$634,625) to plan, design, construct, furnish and equip phase 2 of the Whitfield visitor and education center for the Valencia soil and water conservation district in Valencia county

BELEN EAGLE PARK FIELDS IMPROVE

three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) to plan, design and rehabilitate the grass fields and sprinkler systems at Eagle park in Belen in Valencia county

BOSQUE FARMS CMTY CTR KITCHEN CONSTRUCT

one hundred sixty thousand dollars (\$160,000) to design and construct an addition to the kitchen at the community center in Bosque Farms in Valencia county

three hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$375,000) to plan, design, construct, purchase, equip and install phase 2 improvements to a community center and park, including outdoor basketball courts, a baseball field, a playground and walking paths, in Peralta in Valencia county

one hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$125,000) to purchase and equip public works department equipment in Peralta in Valencia county

one million five hundred thirty-seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,537,500) to plan, design and construct road and safety improvements to El Cerro Mission road in Valencia county

LOS LUNAS EAST/WEST CORRIDOR PLAN PH 1

three hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$350,000) to plan and design phase 1 of the east/west corridor for Los Lunas in Valencia county

NM HWY 109 & BNSF RR INTERSECTION IMPROVE

ten million dollars (\$10,000,000) to plan, design and construct a grade separation and related safety improvements at the intersection of New Mexico highway 109, also known as Jarales road, and the BNSF railroad in Valencia county, contingent upon receiving matching funds in the amount of ten million dollars (\$10,000,000) from sources other than the state

one million seven hundred thirty-five thousand dollars (\$1,735,000) to plan, design and construct a flood protection retention pond in Belen in Valencia county

I-25 BELEN INTERCHANGE CONSTRUCT

six million four hundred thousand dollars (\$6,400,000) to plan, design and construct a westward connection to the existing north interchange in Belen in Valencia county

I-25 AND MORRIS RD INTERCHANGE VALENCIA CO

three hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$350,000) to plan, design and construct an interchange at interstate highway 25 and Morris road, and an extension to New Mexico state road 314, in Valencia county

PERALTA ROADS IMPROVE

three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) to plan, design and construct road improvements in Peralta in Valencia county

RIO COMMUNITIES DRAINAGE PLAN

one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for a drainage master plan and to plan, design and construct drainage improvements in Rio Communities in Valencia county

RIO COMMUNITIES LED STREET LIGHTING

fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to plan, design, purchase, equip and install solar-powered light-emitting diode street lighting in Rio Communities in Valencia county
