I request that the following be funded:

ANIMAS SENIOR CTR FEASIBILITY STUDY

twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) to develop a feasibility study in conjunction with Hidalgo county and the Animas public school district to create a senior center in Animas in Hidalgo county

three million five hundred thousand dollars (\$3,500,000) to plan, design and construct flood control facilities, including a flood diversion berm, ponding detention areas and a bridge, at the Columbus land port of entry in Columbus in Luna county

seven hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$750,000) to acquire and improve land for an economic development business accelerator in Deming in Luna county

DEMING INFO TECH & 911 DISPATCH FCLTY REN

seven hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$750,000) to plan, design, construct, renovate, furnish and equip improvements to the facility that houses the information technology and 911 dispatch offices in Deming in Luna county

DEMING RECREATIONAL REUSE STRG POND SITE IMPROVE

seven hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$750,000) to plan, design, equip and construct site improvements for the Deming recreational reuse storage pond project in Deming in Luna county

LUNA CO CMTY HEALTH & WELL BEING COMPLX IMPROVE

two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) to plan, design, construct, renovate, furnish and equip improvements to the Luna county community health and well being complex, including roof replacement, heating, ventilation and air conditioning systems, electrical systems and parking, in Deming in Luna county
